

THE ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The graduate academic year at New College consists of two fourteen-week semesters. Each semester is divided into two seven-week modules, with a one-week recess between them and a one-week exam/evaluation period at the end of the term. Holidays

The College does not schedule graduate classes on official state holidays that occur during the fall or spring semesters. These holidays include Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving, and the day after Thanksgiving.
