- Successful completion of all credit and non-credit courses in the first and second years of the program as listed in the Academic Program

- A minimum of 3.00 cumulative grade point average (GPA) by the end of the program

Graduate Grading System

All grades except IN (Incomplete), NGR (No Grade Reported), W (Withdrawn), and XX (Audit) are used in calculating a student's GPA. Graduate students must maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average to be eligible to earn a degree.
